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**Policy Statements**

A. All Level I trauma patients will have at least the following admission lab work drawn.

**Procedure**

- A. Blood Stat: CBC, Type and screen
- B. Blood Routine: Ethanol, PT/PTT
- C. Urine: Drug Screen, Any woman of child bearing age (up to the age of sixty) should have a urine HCG completed.
- D. A spun HCT, Point of Care Lactate and Venous Blood Gas with saturation should be drawn unless deemed unnecessary by the attending physicians.
- E. ROTEM- Ex TEM (Extrinsic Thromboelastometry) and Fib TEM (Fibrinogen Thromboelastometry)
- F. Other laboratory tests may also be drawn at the discretion of the attending physician.
