Urologic Trauma Guideline**

- Renal salvage should be attempted for all stable patients with renal injuries
- Antibiotics are not indicated for urologic trauma unless the UA or UCX is positive
- Consultation for renal trauma should be as follows:

Indications for Urology Consult

Kidney

1. All AAST Grade 4 renal injuries
2. Penetrating abdominal injury (SW, GSW) and gross hematuria
3. Selective consultation -- AAST Grade 1-3 injuries

Ureter

1. All ureteral injuries
2. Proximity ureteral GSWs.

Bladder

1. Injuries that involve the trigone or in proximity to the ureter
2. All extraperitoneal bladder ruptures
3. Selective consultation -- intraperitoneal bladder injury (non-trigone)

Urethra

All urethral injuries

Note: Individualized, clinical judgment supercedes all written guidelines.
